eitoeiko is pleased to present "Now and Things," a solo exhibition by Jun Homma from July 1 to July 22. This is Homma's first solo exhibition at our gallery.

Jun Homma has presented installations, photographs, and performances that mimic landscapes and humorously capture human illusions. By blocking out and hiding parts of the landscape, the artist has made viewers aware of the invisible parts of the landscape and developed them into works that remind us of our hidden history, past lives, and social systems. The artist believes that the human ability to supplement, imagine, and understand what cannot be observed is a measure of control over time, a tool to replay the past and change the future. Today, the spread of false information via the Internet and AI has drastically changed our perception of time. Homma captures the times in which incidents and history that should not exist are faked, distorted, and acted as if they were real. In this exhibition, Homma will present new multi-media works that are part sculpture, part photography, and part installation, showing the absolute place of the "now" in between the waves of time, between disappearance and rebirth.

Jun Homma

Born in 1967, Tokyo. Homma received his B.A. from Tama Art University, 1990. Research student in department of sculpture at Tama Art University, 1990-92. Homma stayed in GlogauAIR, Berlin, with a fellowship of Overseas Study Program for Artists by Agency for Cultural Affairs Japan, 2019.
